FINDING THE KRAUSE TREE FARM

★ S4776 Krause Lane, Viroqua, WI (in case of inclement weather will meet in barn)

From Richland Center

Follow HWY 14 WEST to Hwy 56
(W Broadway St) in Viroqua
Turn LEFT & follow HWY 56 3 mi to Krause Ln
Turn LEFT on Krause Ln follow to the end

From La Crosse

Follow HWY 35 SOUTH to Main St in Genoa
Turn LEFT on Main St, follow 0.3 mi to HWY 56
Turn LEFT & HWY 56 about 17 miles to Krause Ln
Turn RIGHT on Krause Ln follow to the end
