FINDING THE KARPINSKY TREE FARM

W7698 Phillips Rd, Poynette, WI

From Poynette

Head NORTH on US 51 about 5 miles
Turn RIGHT on Phillips Rd
1.3 miles to W7698 driveway on left (north)

From Portage

Head SOUTH on US 51 about 6.5 miles
Turn LEFT on Phillips Rd
1.3 miles to W7698 driveway on left (north)
